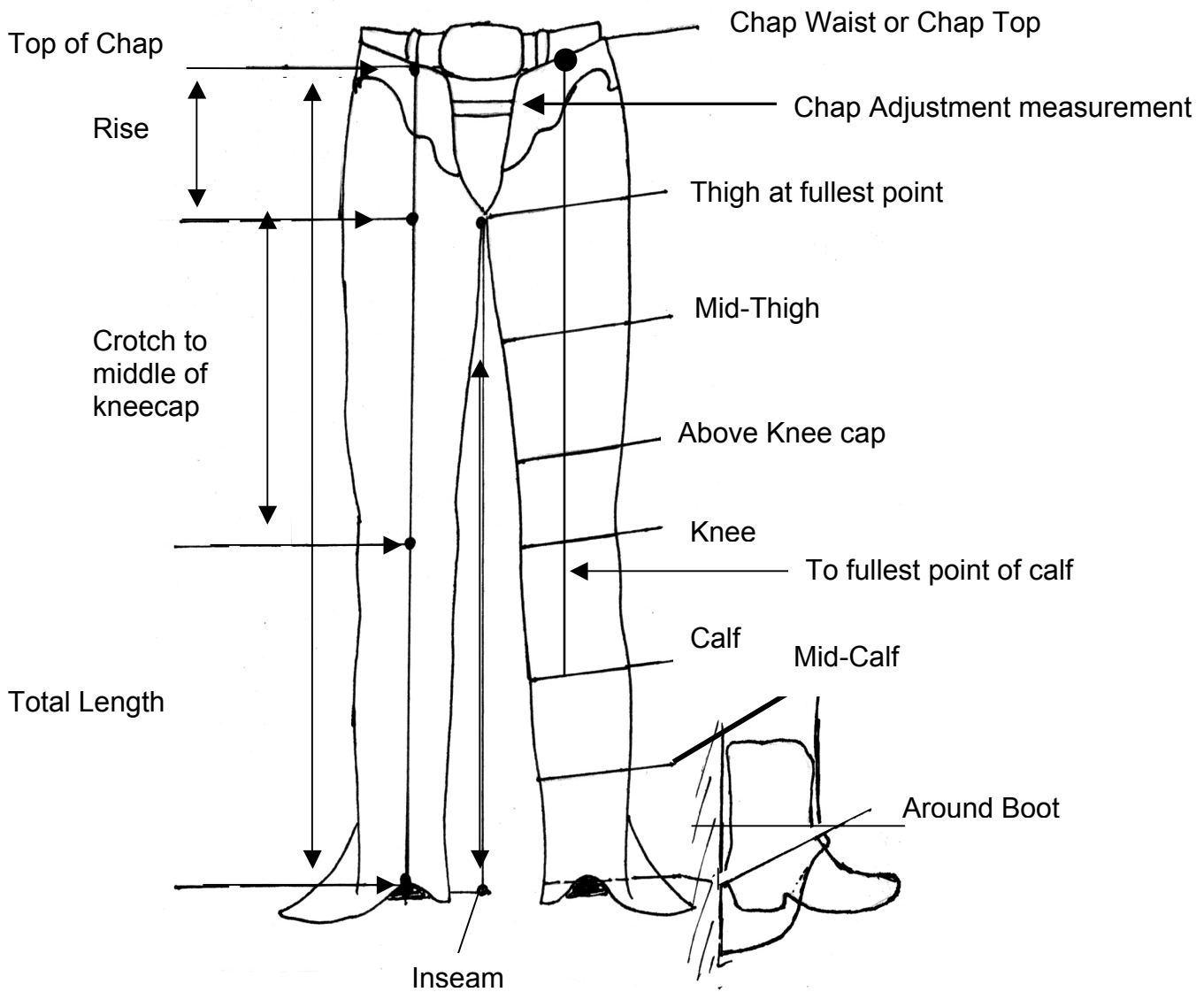

Term	Definition	Measurements				
Chap Waist	Measure all the way around at the base of the belt loops OR AT THE HEIGHT THAT YOU WANT THE CHAP TO BE ON YOUR WAIST. If a lower or higher waist style is preferred, measure around that point. This will be the very top of the chaps.	-

Mid Calf	Measure about 4" lower than the calf measurement.	<table border="1"> <tr> <td>Left</td> <td>Right</td> </tr> <tr> <td>-</td> <td>-</td> </tr> </table>	Left	Right	-	-

Around boot	Measure all the way around the boot at the ankle. Make sure you are wearing the boots you'll be using.	-				
Rise	Place the beginning of your tape measure at the base of the belt loop of pants fitting up on the waist (or where chap top is to be), and measure downward to a point that would be in line with the crotch. Your purpose is to measure how high you want your chaps to come up on your torso.	-				
To the middle of Knee	Measure from the crotch or top of thigh down the front of your leg to the center of the <u>kneecap</u> .	-				
To the fullest part of Calf	Measure from the crotch or top of thigh down the front of your leg to the level of the fullest point of your <u>calf</u> .	-				
Total length of chap	With your tape measure still at the base of the belt loop (or chap top), measure down the front of the leg, keeping your measurement against the leg, to the desired length at the instep of the foot.	-				
Inseam	Measure from crotch down to floor on inside of leg	-				
	UNLESS YOU HAVE A DISTINCT DIFFERENCE IN RIGHT & LEFT LEG SIZES, only one leg measurement on right OR left leg is needed. IF not sure, please give both right & left measurements.	-

Please take your time when measuring and do NOT pull the tape tight. Hold tape at a **comfortable** snugness. Most leathers will stretch a little and loosen up just a bit.
